Objectives:

- To encourage, strengthen and grow the body of Christ. To share His love and truth while trekking through and to a number of Buddhist and Hindu villages.
- To possibly purchase land for the first Christian church in the entire district of Humla (an area roughly the size of Delaware and Rhode Island combined).
- To shine the light of Jesus while working at our C4C partner orphanage just outside of Kathmandu.

Tentative Itinerary:

March 14-16	The trekking team (Gary, Matthew, Brandy, Edward and Jordan) travels to Nepal and meet with C4C member and partner, Megh Gurung
March 17	The orphanage team (Leanne and Elaine) will begin travel to Nepal as the trekkers begin to make their way to Nepal's far-west, traveling from Kathmandu to Nepalgunj
March 18	Leanne and Elaine will arrive in Nepal today and meet with C4C member and ministry partner, Pastor Tej Rokka, while the trekking team flies from Nepalgunj to Simikot
March 19-25	The trekking team will begin hiking to Humla villages in search of divine appointments to encourage the few believers there and share the Good News with the lost. The orphanage team will minister to the children through VBS style teachings with songs, crafts, and Bibles stories. They will also conduct a one-day women's conference scheduled for Saturday, March 21.
March 26	Final day loving on the children at the orphanage, while trekkers make their way from Simikot through Nepalgunj to Kathmandu
March 27-29	After a day of rest and recovery in Katmandu, Leanne, Gary, Elaine, Matthew, Brandy, Edward and Jordan will travel to their respective homes

Prayer Points:

- Safety for the team as they travel to, in and from Nepal.
- Opportunities to serve and bless the few believers in the far-west (Nepal is 75 percent Hindu and 16 percent Buddhist).
- Many divine appointments, open doors and open hearts to share the love and truth of Jesus with the lost.
- Wisdom and provision for the potential church-build in Simikot.
- The children at the orphanage to know Jesus Christ in a deeper and richer way through the VBS style program and the love and teaching of Leanne and Elaine.
