Mission Objective:

- † Trekking into the Cordillera Huayhuash range of the Peruvian Andes to share the love and truth of Jesus Christ with remote Quechua farming communities.
- † To be an encouragement to C4C's missionary to Peru, Jaime Servat, and sponsored climber, Edwin Milla.

Tentative Itinerary:

August 3..... Flights from USA to Lima, Peru.

August 4..... Travel from Lima to Huaraz (3,052 meters/10,013 feet).

August 5-6..... Acclimatization hikes near Huaraz (up to 4,200 meters/13,800 feet).

August 7-14..... Drive to Llamac. Trek for eight days around the entire Huayhuash area and back to Llamac, while conducting outreach to farmers and trekkers. Elevations up to 5,000 meters/16,404 feet. Return to Huaraz.

August 15-16.... Travel from Huaraz to Lima for overnight flights to USA.

Prayer Points:

- † Safety, strength and good health for the team as they travel and trek.
- † A richly blessed time of fellowship and encouragement among the entire team.
- † Filling of the Holy Spirit so that each member would boldly exercise their spiritual gifts.
- † Many divine appointments and open doors to share Christ with those the team will encounter – especially while trekking in the Huayhuash.
