Tej, Megh, Gary, Brandy and Matthew will trek throughout remote Humla, delivering the Good News and providing medical assistance as needed

### Day Fourteen:

Saturday, April 5

Today, the team will trek back to Simikot and again worship with believers.

### Day Fifteen:

Sunday, April 6

The team will fly from Simikot through Nepalgunj and back to Kathmandu.

### Days Sixteen-Seventeen:

Monday, April 7– Tuesday, April 8

Gary, Brandy and Matthew will make their way back to their homes in North America.
