Pray for strength and endurance.</p>	<p><i>July 31</i> Just after 3 am, the team begins an attempt at the summit. Afterward, everyone will descend back to Base Camp. Pray for safety and physical stamina.</p>	<p><i>August 1</i> This morning the team descends to Cevirme village, where they hope to meet villagers and semi-nomads. Pray for many divine appointments and open doors.</p>	<p><i>August 2</i> The team remains in Cevirme village today. Please pray for more hearts to be open to the love of Jesus, and for relationships to be built.</p>	<p><i>August 3</i> Today the team travels back to Van. Pray for a fruitful time in this historic city and for divine appointments.</p>
<p><i>August 4</i> The team travels back to Istanbul today. Please pray for safety and for open doors to share about the Lord.</p>	<p><i>August 5</i> Team members return to their respective homes in US.
